



THE VINEYARD Ueberroth Vineyard is located at the southern end of the foggy and windy Petaluma Gap region of the Sonoma Coast. Planting began in 2019 under the direction of grower Keri Ueberroth and vineyard manager Tyler Klick. 11 acres of Chardonnay clone 4 are planted on 1616c root stock at the lowest section of the vineyard where the cold fog settles in. 40 acres of Pinot Noir and two acres of Wente clone Chardonnay are planted in the rolling hills of Diablo Clay soils on steep inclines. Sojourn's blocks of clone 943, 4, and Pommard are planted on 3309 rootstock. Each block has a slightly different aspect to the sun and offers up unique characteristics. This is one of the coolest sites we work with and the resulting wines are balanced and distinctive.

WINEMAKER NOTES In 2023, plentiful winter rains took Sonoma out of a drought. A cool summer allowed the vines to ripen at an even pace and the weather stayed moderate during the growing season with periodic light rains. Harvesting started three weeks later than normal and Pinot Noir yields were above average. The cooler weather resulted in fresh natural acidity and firmer tannins, both good for cellaring. Grape phenolics ripened at lower sugar levels and the resulting 2023 Pinot Noirs are more "Burgundian" in nature. 2023 was our first vintage producing an Ueberroth vineyard designate Pinot Noir. The vines matured slowly and we picked blocks in multiple phases as each section ripened. The 2023 blend is comprised mostly of clone 943 and Mt Eden with Pommard adding complexity, structure and forest floor notes.
